



## YOUR HUNT

Our six day long hunt begins with your arrival at Turpin Meadow Ranch the day before your hunt begins. A pre-dawn breakfast starts Day 1 and nourishes you for our departure in the Teton Wilderness. As you travel on horseback through this ruggedly beautiful country you will realize it has little changed from the days when mountain men such as Jim Bridger and John Colter explored this area over one hundred fifty years ago. And, just like the mountain men, you and your horse will occasionally need rest, so at times, you will be leading your horse down the steeper portions of the trail.

Hunting will begin on Day 1 and will continue through the evening of Day 6. Hunting parties typically consist of two hunters per guide, but with prior arrangement, you can have a private guide. Also, there will normally be no more than four hunters at the Ranch at any one time.

Over the years, many of the bull elk taken from the hunting areas within the Teton Wilderness area have scored well above the 300 class as measured by the Boone and Crockett Club. After you come to understand the difficult nature of hunting elk, you may find that a nice 5x6 or 6/6 bull is indeed a "trophy." A hunting session in the Teton Wilderness offers plentiful hunting opportunities, a magnificent wilderness setting and an experience that is not to be forgotten.
