



PRECAUTIONS

The safety of everyone in camp is of paramount importance, so please pay close attention to our rules and our guides. In the Teton Wilderness Area, safety starts with firearms and extends to the dangers of the rugged terrain and wildlife (i.e. grizzly bears). All safety matters will be approached with a “no compromises” policy.

Please understand that to insure everyone’s safety, all firearms will be managed by our guides and the manager during your wilderness experience. This policy is in effect from the time you leave the ranch corral until you return to the corral.

Please remember that grizzly bears live throughout the Teton Wilderness Area, so all your hunting and riding will be done in grizzly bear country. Therefore, we require you to carry a can of 10% Oleoresin Capsicum pepper spray on you belt as your primary protection from grizzly bears. Our guides have turned away charging grizzly bears in the past using this spray, and it has not failed them. Plus, you do not have to be nearly as accurate with the spray as you must with a firearm, and neither bears nor humans can be permanently harmed through the use of spray. You can carry a handgun for other purposes though.
